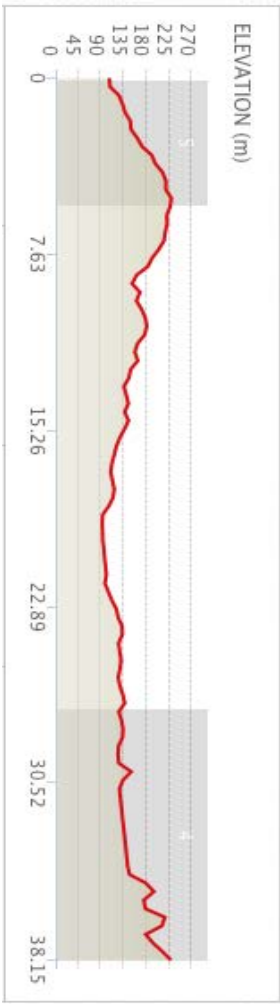

TRAIL NOTES

The Lilydale to Warburton Rail Trail is a recreation trail for walkers, cyclists and horse riders that follows the path of the historical railway line which was established in the 1900s to service the agricultural industry of the time.

Gravel path with gentle gradients. Opportunities to step-off/step-on at various points.



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
