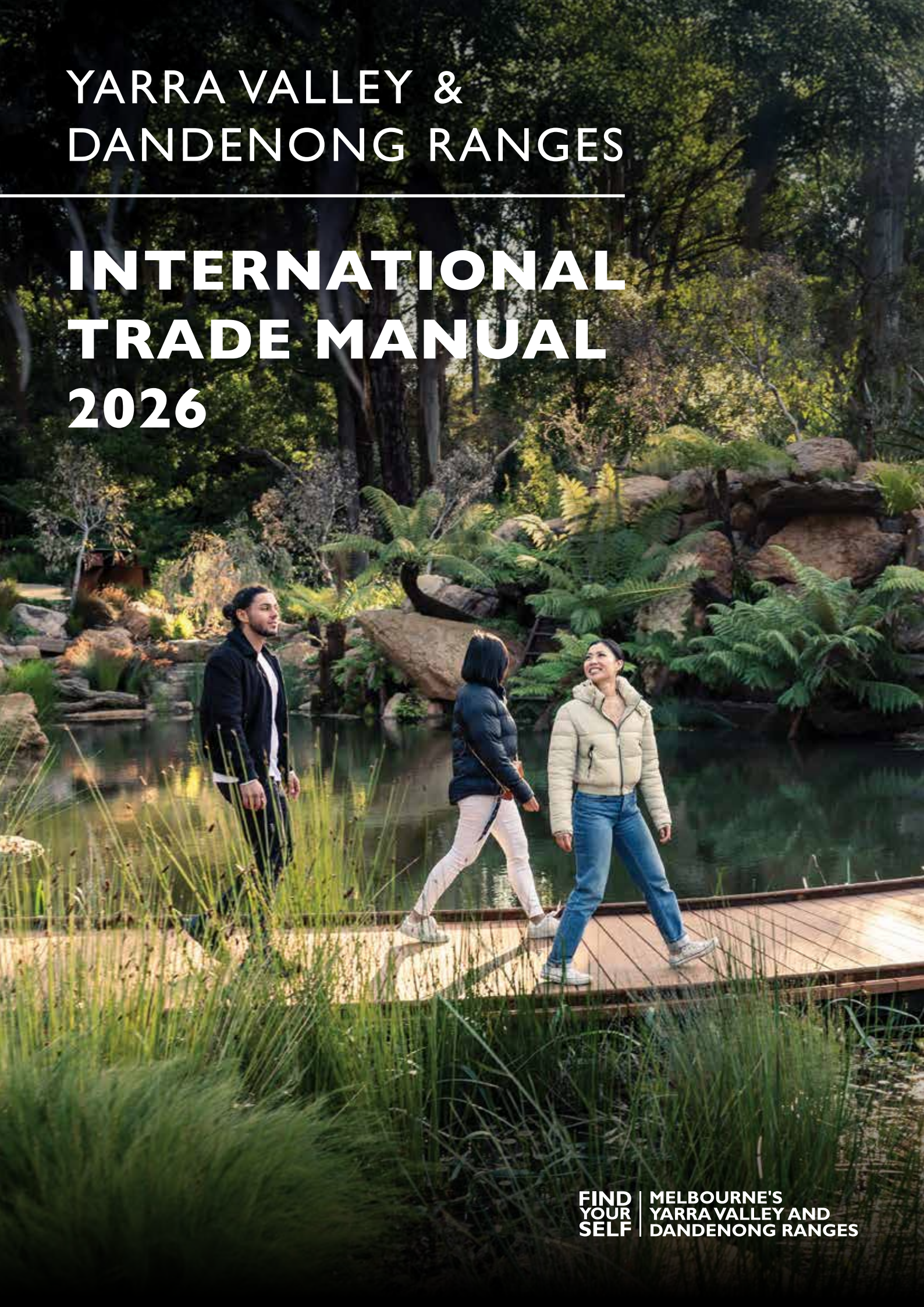

### YARRA VALLEY

Globally-recognised wineries and distilleries live here: Chandon, De Bortoli, Rochford, Coombe Yarra Valley, Oakridge and Four Pillars Gin Distillery. There's nothing like getting to know them at the source and sampling their produce.

Imagine watching daybreak over the valley from a hot air balloon, then coming back to earth for a sparkling wine breakfast before setting off for a day of nature-based adventure and more feasting.

Maybe an early round of golf as kangaroos watch on, then onto Healesville Sanctuary to experience Australia's majestic Spirits of the Sky Presentation.

Find your sweet spot by picking cherries straight from the tree at CherryHill Orchards (November to January).

### THE DANDENONG RANGES MELBOURNE'S CLOSEST MOUNTAIN RANGE OF HIDDEN DELIGHTS

A pleasant 30 minutes drive and you are up in the Dandenong Ranges where you can take advantage of the views over Melbourne.

Step into the tranquillity of clean country air as you wander the walking tracks through lush forests of giant Mountain Ash. Enjoy village life and shop the many Australian made craft boutiques and galleries.

Tip-toe through the largest display of tulips in the southern hemisphere at the Tesselaar Tulip Festival (September to October) wander through an edible forest or botanical display gardens.

### Approx average daytime temperatures:

Spring: 19 C - (September, October, November)

Summer: 26 C - (December, January, February)

Autumn: 20 C - (March, April, May)

Winter: 14 C - (June, July, August)

### Summer

- Cherry picking at CherryHill Orchards, November to January.
- Chelsea Australian Garden at Olinda.

### Autumn

- KaBloom Flower Festival, Tesselaar, March to April.
- Grape harvest, scenic drives alongside vineyards, April to May.
- An array of autumn colours from vineyards and the Dandenong Ranges.

### Winter

- Closest snow play to Melbourne at Lake Mountain Alpine Resort and Mount Donna Buang (approx 1.5 - 2 hours) from late June to August.

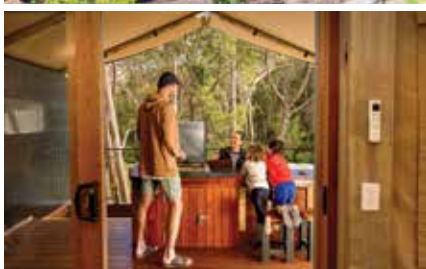
